

Walsh Hall Suggested Packing List:

BASICS

○ PERSONAL

- Shower Caddie, Wash cloth/Loofah, Shower flip flops
- 3 towels: Hair, Body, Face
- Toiletries; Basic First Aid; Handsoap; any preferred vitamins
- Any prescription medications (can be filled at pharmacy on campus)
- Bedding: Extra-long twin sheets (80”), Comforter, Pillow, Pillow Case
- Laundry Basket/Bag and Detergent—make sure it’s labeled!
- Clothes: South Bend experiences ALL the seasons so bring layers!
- Umbrella/Raincoat/Rainboots
- Laptop/Phone/Chargers (computer clusters are all over campus, but having your own is very convenient)
- ND Safety Package (includes Masks)
- Pictures of home, friends and family

○ ROOM

- Fan: small one for bed/desk, talk to roommate about larger one
- Basic School Supplies
- Extension cords, power strip
- Cup, plate, bowl, utensils, dish towel, dish soap
- Basic cleaning supplies; hand sanitizer
- Stackable/Vertical Storage (Walsh has high ceilings!)
- Reading Light/Night Light
- Masking tape for posters/decor

Discuss with Roommate FIRST!

*It may be better to each bring/buy different items you both want to use, rather than splitting the cost of these. It makes move-out and transitioning rooms in future years much easier. *None of these are necessities except the fan and fridge.**

- Decorations
- Storage Options
- Mini-Fridge
- Room Fan(s)
- Carpet/Rugs
- Couch/Futon: Most Walsh FY won’t have room, though, so wait until you arrive and it can be delivered to your door.
- TV/DVD Player/Speakers
- Game Systems
- Floor Lamps
- Dust Buster/ Mini-Vacuum
- Small Tool Kit

OPTIONAL

○ PERSONAL

- Simple Bathrobe: for walking to communal bathroom
- Reusable Waterbottle
- Some non-perishable snacks
- Headphones: respect your roommate's study time!
- Keurigs are allowed, but try a french press for more sustainability!
- Collapsible Drying Rack, Batteries, Travel sewing kit, Stamps
- Décor Items
- [If you plan on working on campus, then you need official identification—not copies-- including Passport or Social Security Card/Birth Certificate/Driver’s License].
- Bicycle and Bike Lock (must be stored outside at rack, so need a lock)

○ ROOM

- Dry Erase Markers for your door (dry erase board comes with each room)
- Egg carton pad or mattress pad
- Desk organizer
- Bed Risers: if you don’t bunk your beds, gives more room for storage
- Plastic drawers or thin tubs for storage
- Back of Door Hanging Racks: Pad the edges to avoid damaging door
- Hanging shoe bags offer vertical storage for more than just shoes!
- Hanging jewelry organizers are amazing space savers, too!
- Clothes hangers ([Wonder Hanger](#) saves so much space!)

DO NOT BRING

- Large Fridge (cannot exceed 5.0 cubic feet), Ceiling Fans, Water Beds
- Microwave: Walsh has one on every floor
- Hot plates, toasters, toaster ovens, george foreman grills
- Portable Air Conditioners (including dual purpose fans)
- Pets (non-carnivorous fish are ok, but tanks need to be under 30 gallons)
- Self Stick floor tiles, Carpet Tape, Nails, Adhesive Squares, Poster Putty
- Candles, Incense (including any other items with open flames)
- Halogen lamps with bulbs higher than 300 watts
- A car—First years are not permitted to have cars on campus
- Hoverboards or electric scooters
- Printer—Walsh has its own printer, but they are permitted if you choose
